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Graph: Basic Economy Accrual

Frequent flyer programs have applied special conditions to the accrual of miles/points related to basic economy fares. There are two exceptions. United does not reduce accrual for their basic economy fares. Southwest does not have basic economy fares, but does use a different accrual multiplier for each of their branded fares. For Alaska, which is a miles-based program, the reduction made for basic economy is applied to mileage flown, not the fare.


